

In Aruba, the rate of adolescent fertility has decreased since 2010. The rate in 2021 was nearly the same as the average rate in its income group.

112.5% of girls and 102.4% of boys complete lower secondary school in Aruba as of 2014 data

The gap in lower secondary completion rate between boys and girls, 10.1, is larger than the gap of the Latin America & Caribbean aggregate, 3.9. Lower secondary education completion rate measures how many children have completed the last grade of lower secondary education regardless of age completed.

In Aruba, both women and men have very high literacy rates. Adult literacy rate is the percentage of people ages 15 and above who can both read and write with understanding a short simple statement about their everyday life.
