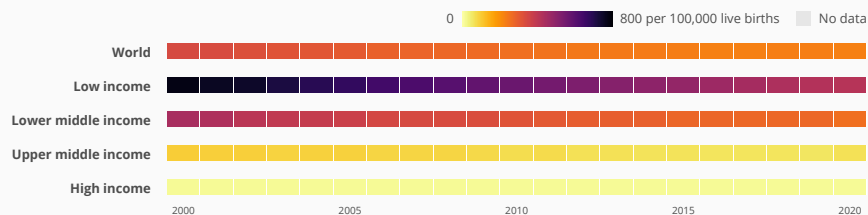




Health

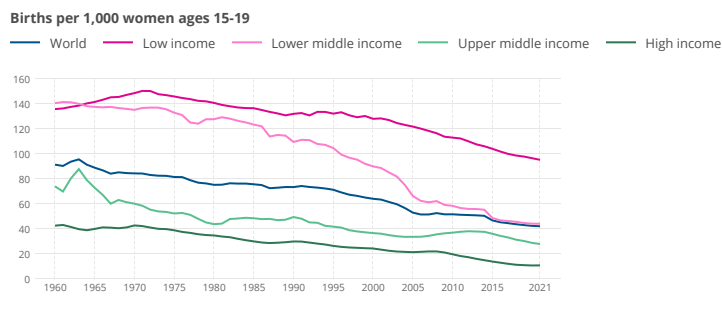

Maternal mortality ratio by world and income group



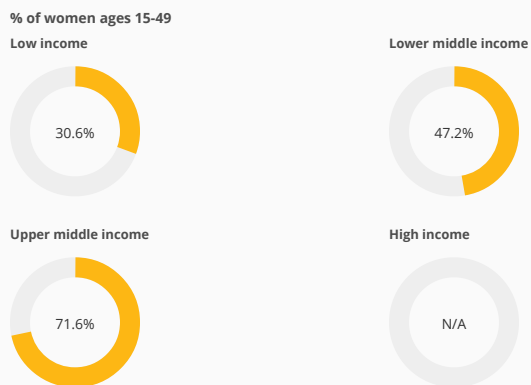

Adolescent fertility by world and income group



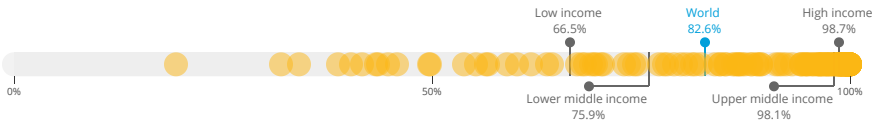

per 1,000 uninfected population ages 15-49

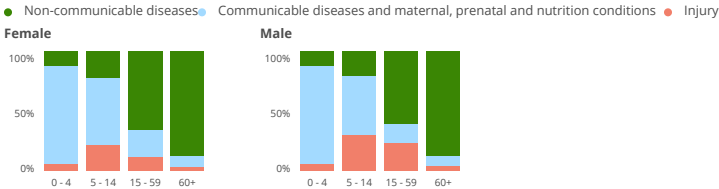
